NOTIFICATION

No. A.46012/1/2022-GAD/Pt, the 17th March, 2025: In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 166 of the Constitution, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Government of Mizoram (Allocation of Business) Rules, 2019 as follows, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Government of Mizoram (Allocation of Business) (Amendment) Rules, 2025
(2) They shall come into force with effect from the 1st of April, 2025.
2. Amendment of the Second Schedule.- In the Government of Mizoram (Allocation of Business) Rules, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules), in the Second Schedule, under the heading "Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Department, entry at Sl. 10 shall be omitted.
3. Amendment of the Third Schedule.- (1) In the principal rules, in the Third Schedule, for the heading "Tribal Affairs and Culture Department", the following shall be substituted, namely:-
" Art and Culture Department"
(2) In the Third Schedule of the principal rules, under the heading "Art and Culture Department" entries under Sl. No. 11 to 18 shall be omitted
4. Amendment of the Twenty Eighth Schedule.- In the Twenty Eighth Schedule of the principal rules, under the heading "Planning and Programme Implementation Department", after Sl. No. 28, the following entries shall be inserted namely:-
"29. Welfare matters relating to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes/Weaker sections of the society.

EXPLANATION : The term “Welfare matters” relating to SCs/STs under Sl. No. 29 may constitute the following:-

- i. Charities and charitable institutions, charitable and religious endowments to subject dealt within the Department.
- ii. Matters pertaining to socio-economic, cultural and educational status of SCs/STs.
- iii. Funding of programmes and projects for the welfare of SCs/STs including Multi-sectoral Development Programme.
- iv. Welfare matters relating to National Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes

30. The Scheduled Tribe, and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.

31. Grants under article 275(1) of the Constitution

32. Support to Tribal Research Institute Scheme

33. Grant in aid to voluntary organisations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribe

34. Eklavya Model Residential Schools

35. Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA)”

5. Amendment of the Thirty Fourth Schedule.-

In the Thirty Fourth Schedule of the principal rules, under the heading “Rural Development and Administration Department”, after Sl. No. 24, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:-

“25. Biogas development”

6. Amendment of the Thirty Eighth Schedule.-

In the Thirty Eighth Schedule of the principal rules, under the heading “Social Welfare, Women and Child Development Department”, entry at Sl. 18 shall be omitted
