On this day, the United Nations Flag is flown alongwith the Indian National Flag on all buildings on which the National Flag is regularly flown in the States/Union Territories. The United Nations Flag is, however, <u>not</u> flown on Raj Bhawans / Raj Niwases and buildings housing Legislative Councils, Legislative Assemblies and High Courts.

In terms of para 3.36 of the Flag Code of India,2002, "When the United Nations' Flag is flown along with the National Flag, it can be displayed on either side of the National Flag. The general practice is to fly the National Flag on the extreme right with reference to the direction which it is facing (i.e. extreme left of an observer facing the masts flying the Flags)."

Therefore, all Administrative Departments and all Heads of Offices are instructed to ensure that the above instruction is followed
