- 4) To monitor all land acquisition cases pertaining to major infrastructure projects like National Highways, Railways etc.
- 5) To ensure that all necessary clearances such as Forest Clearance, Environment Clearance etc. are obtained on time and such Clearances do not delay scheduled progress and completion of the projects and programmes.

The Committee shall meet at least once a month and submit report as and when required.
